OUR CURRICULUM

This half term we will be settling into nursery and making new friends in the classroom. Also, we will be exploring the different areas and learning about the rules we need to follow in nursery. COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

MATHEMATICS

In mathematics we will be learning all about numbers and how to count from 1-10. Starting to look at what the different numbers look like and different shapes and colours too.

This term we will be talking about our families and making portraits while looking at the different features we have.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN
