Terms of Reference

- 1. 10 pupils from Years 5 and 6 make up the Reading Ambassadors for William Byrd.
- 2. The Reading Ambassadors will be assigned two Key Stage 1 students to support their reading development.
- 3. The Reading Ambassadors will be responsible for monitoring the school library and requesting new books.
- 4. The Reading Ambassadors will co-run lunchtime reading sessions to promote reading for pleasure and sharing the deep enjoyment of reading a great book with others.
- 5. The Reading Ambassadors will run reading assemblies, help to organise and run school book fairs and World Book Week.
- 6. The Reading Ambassadors will assist in monitor reading corners in classrooms (ensure they are inviting and up to date), assist with purchasing new

books and will review books to help other children with their recommendations.
