

## Anti-Bullying Ambassador

### *Terms of Reference*

1. Nine children from Years 5-6 will be appointed the role of Anti-Bullying Ambassador by Miss Houston and SLT.
2. The Anti-Bullying Ambassadors will meet in The Nest on alternative Fridays at 12.30 to discuss any upcoming campaigns and events. Observations from playground duties will also be discussed and successful practices will be shared and celebrated.
3. The Anti-Bullying Ambassadors will follow a rota system to be on duty in the playground every playtime and lunchtime. They will wear sashes to be easily identifiable to their peers. Their role in the playground will be to be an upstander against bullying behaviour, tackling situations in a positive way. They will promote kind behaviours.
4. Within the role they will also act as Peer Mentor Wellbeing leads, focussing on the wellbeing of all students in the school (including being a good listener, offering guidance and advice).
5. Anti-Bullying Ambassadors will be responsible for reporting any incidents of bullying behaviour to Mrs Houston or another trusted adult within the school.
6. Members will participate in ongoing training to develop the skills required to fulfil their roles and to have the tools to prevent bullying behaviours happening in our school.

7. As part of their role, Anti-Bullying Ambassadors will promote good friendly behaviour and kindness by being good role models adhering to WBPA guiding powers at all times

8. Anti-Bullying Ambassador badges will be worn as part of their uniform so they are visible to their peers. Anti-Bullying Ambassadors will be committed to take part in the Princess Diana anti-bullying campaigns to earn additional badges. They will be involved in the planning and implementing of activities and events to spread the Anti-Bullying message. Anti-Bullying Ambassadors will be expected to lead assemblies on national Anti-Bullying week.

9. Further responsibilities will include taking part in pupil voice in order to understand their peer's knowledge of bullying behaviours and their feelings towards school to ensure that all pupils feel safe and happy in our school.

Our Anti-Bullying Ambassadors will be successful if:

- Every member is inspired to prevent bullying behaviours
- We are passionate about shaping attitudes and changing behaviours to spread the Anti-Bullying message
- We are good listeners
- We are supportive of each other and work together to support those experiencing bullying behaviour
- We are role models of positive behaviours
- We are respectful of others feelings
