

How to get to...

Yiewsley Methodists Halls, Upstairs Hall (stairs or lift)
Fairfield Road UB7 8ES next to Wilkos/Wilkinsons (now closed) and Key House (REAP office), just off the main Yiewsley High Street,



It is easier to first find Key House, which is the old Town Hall on the corner of Yiewsley High Street and Fairfield Road. It has a clock on the roof. Then when you look at Key House, the Methodists Halls are just to the right after Wilkos/Wilkinsons. There will be a sign on the door of the Halls.

Parking is a bit difficult round here. There is Pay and Display in a Council car park behind Wilkos and the Methodist Halls – you turn under the passage / tunnel under flats, beside Wilkos / the Methodist Halls. It can be £6-10 for people who are not resident in the borough.

Please be sure your ticket covers the whole time you need as they often give parking tickets. There is free parking if you carry on down Fairfield road into the residential streets about 5 mins walk away but look out for the new Resident Parking zone – again, they often give parking tickets.

We recommend the Train – every 15 – 20 mins, Elizabeth Line 25 mins from Paddington. 15-20 from Ealing Broadway / Southall / 5mins Hayes and Harlington to **West Drayton** – then 5 mins walk – see 'Walking') (West Drayton is in Oyster Zone 6).

Walking from West Drayton train station Come out of the main exit and turn left past the bus stops downhill to the main road. At the main road turn right up the hill and over the canal bridge. You will see shops ahead of you. Keep going, past Iceland, and you will see Key House, with the clock on the roof ahead of you on the right hand side of the road. Yiewsley Methodist Halls is 2 doors to the right, after Wilkos 10 mins from train.

Buses 222 from Hounslow or Uxbridge. There are other buses but they are slower and less frequent. 350 from Hayes and Harlington is also quick but the train from Hayes is quicker.
