Dear Parents and Carers

Firstly, I would like to apologise if you have seen any misleading information or if there has been any confusion regarding a Nursery Sports Day.

Our Nursery children do not take part in a formal Sports Day because they do not yet take part in structured PE lessons that prepare children for the types of competitive activities and events seen in the older year groups. Instead, physical development is an integral part of the Nursery curriculum. Every day, children take part in a wide range of carefully planned physical activities that develop their balance, coordination, strength, agility and confidence through active play, both indoors and outdoors.
