

Jack and the Beanstalk with Blanks Levels

Ideas Sheet

These resources can be used in a variety of ways to support children with speech, language and communication needs.

Ideas:

- Read through the PowerPoint with the child/group of children. Repeat this task before asking the questions using the cards or sheets at the appropriate point in the story.
- Read through the PowerPoint story and then ask the children the questions.
- Read through the PowerPoint with the child/group of children. Then sequence the story using the sequencing cards. With the cards in order on the table, ask the questions from the questioning sheet.
- The question cards can be used to support the children to ask each other questions.
- The question cards/question sheet can be mixed up to enable a group of children at different levels to work together.
- The question sheet can be used to record the answers from the activity.
- The question sheet/cards can be used with specific children working towards achieving consistency at that level.
