Our Amazing Results for 2024

All outcomes are significantly above National Averages!

- 84% achieved Grade 4+ for English and Maths in GCSEs
- 68% achieved grade 5+ for English and Maths in GCSEs
- 48% of grades awarded were 9-6 (A**-B)
- Our Maths GCSE grades were in the top 9% of schools in England
- Our Science GCSE grades were in the top 9% of schools in England
- 52% of A Level grades were A*-B
- 100% of students in Year 13 secured a university place or employment
